#### How to achieve the academic badge?

Each term, teachers are invited to nominate **one** student in each of their classes.

Each nomination will get a blue, academic, certificate at the end of term.

10x nominations (certificates) will earn the blue academic badge.







### How to achieve the professional badge?

Students can be nominated for their professional badge at any time. Their tutors, teachers or any staff member in the academy can nominate a student if they feel they have embodied the professional strand of the Brunel Way.

Examples of students earning their professional badge:

- Taking part in student panels for staff interviews.
- Representing BBA at open evenings and parent evenings.
- Taking part in Envision and Future quest.







## How to achieve the social badge?

Students can be nominated for their social badge **at any time.**Their tutors, teachers or any staff member in the academy can nominate a student if they feel they have embodied the social strand of the Brunel Way.

An example of students earning their social badge:

- Being an active participant of an inclusion group during tutor time.







#### How to achieve the personal badge?

Students can be nominated for their personal badge **at any time.** Their tutors, teachers or any staff member in the academy can nominate a student if they feel they have embodied the personal strand of the Brunel Way.

Examples of students earning their personal badge:

- Taking part EmpowerHER integrate project
- Taking part in Project Fearless







## How to achieve the community badge?

Students can be nominated for their community badge at any time. Their tutors, teachers or any staff member in the academy can nominate a student if they feel they have embodied the community strand of the Brunel Way.

Examples of students earning their community badge:

- Being part of the student leadership team.
- Fundraising within the community.
- Giving back to their community volunteering their time.
