Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 7 Camp – 2026

We are pleased to announce that we are planning a four-day, three-night, visit to **Woodhouse Activity Centre** for our Year 7 camp in June 2026. This trip is the perfect opportunity for students to develop their confidence and skills, face fun challenges and to develop some independence. The trip will take place from **Tuesday 23rd – Friday 26th June 2026**.

This is an outdoor camping experience. The activities include climbing challenges, abseiling, an assault course, orienteering and many other exciting team challenges and games. In the evenings there will be several activities and games planned. All students will stay in a camping 'village' and sleep in tents. There will be toilet cabins and showers next to the sleeping tents. Food is included, where they will enjoy dining with friends and be able to catch up about the great day they have had.

The cost of the **four-day trip is £232 per person** and covers the cost of accommodation, all meals, activities, coach travel and insurance. Full payment must be paid by **1st May 2026**. Unfortunately, if payments are missed and you fall behind with the payment schedule, BBA reserves the right to withdraw your child from the trip.

We recognise that this is a significant amount of money. You have the option to pay in 5 monthly instalments from December (*the first payment will act as a non-refundable deposit*) with the final balance to be paid by **1st May 2026**. All payments will need to be made through ParentPay or by cash at reception.

The breakdown of the instalments is detailed below:

In order to secure your child's place on the trip, we will require a **non-refundable deposit of £50** along with a completed online permission form and the Parental Agreement by **1st December 2025**.

Please be aware that all places will be subject to the child's behaviour across the year and BBA reserves the right to remove a child from the trip or not give a place to a student if there are problems with behaviour over the course of the year.

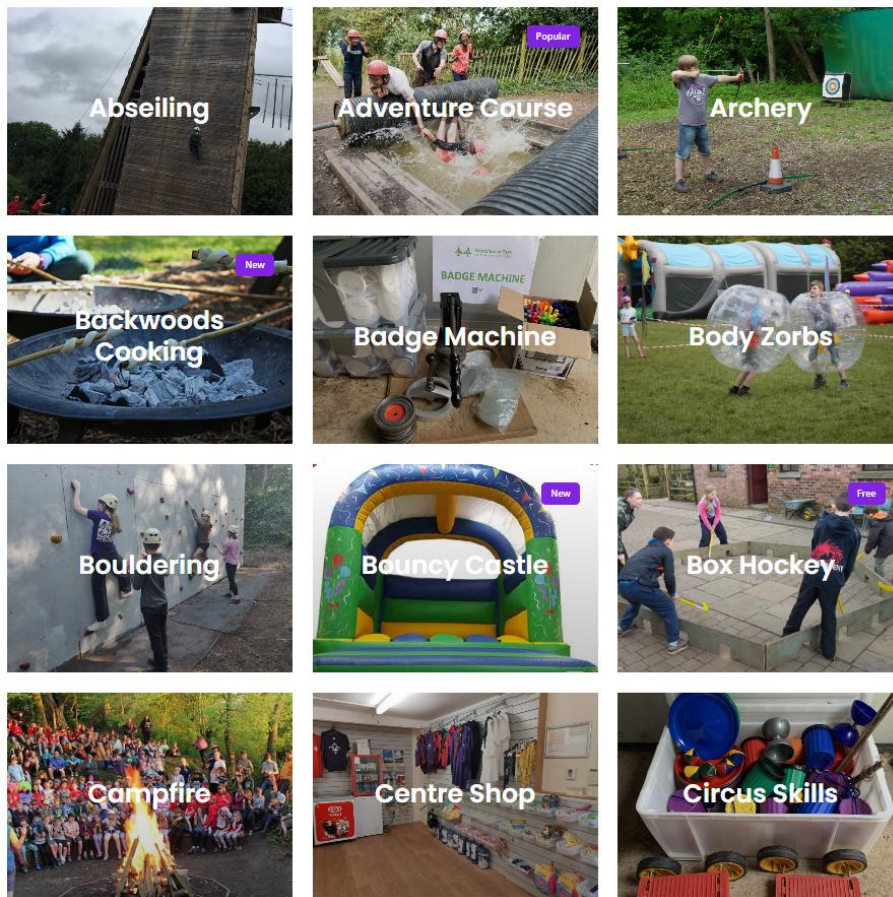
